CRITERIA FOR THE AWARDS

- ◆ **Minimum two years' attendance** at Martin Luther King Elementary School
- ◆ High school diploma or GED, received no earlier than spring, 1999.
- ◆ Acceptance into a program at an accredited post-secondary institution.
- ◆ Document 20 hours of community service earned during high school
- ◆ Write an essay describing your dreams for a career and your future
- ◆ Demonstration of financial need considered, but not necessary

Awards of \$1,000 or more

Awards go directly to the institutions

Progress reports from award recipients requested at the end of the year
